How to Log In and Set Up A MySpace Account

1. You will need an email address to set up your MySpace account and profile page.

1. If you do not have an email address, go to a search engine and in the browser type in: www.Yahoo.com or <click here.
2. In the upper left hand corner of the page, below the Yahoo logo, you'll see a button that says **MY MAIL**. **Click on that "My Mail"**.



On the right hand side, you'll see: "Don't have a Yahoo! ID?...
click "sign up" and follow the steps to setting up a free email account.

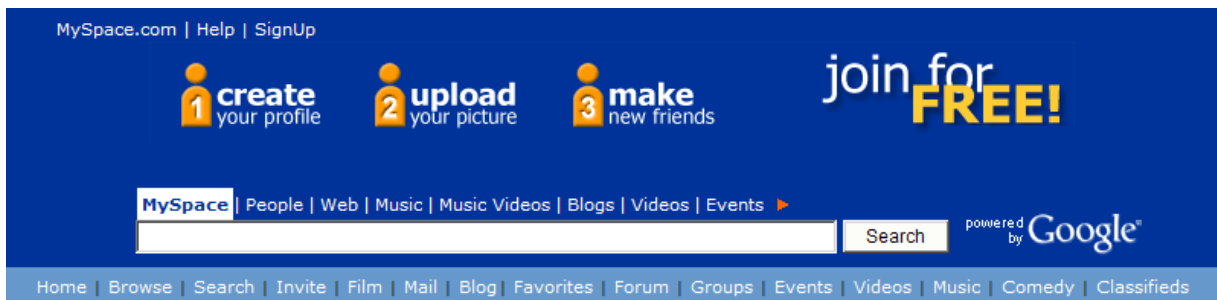

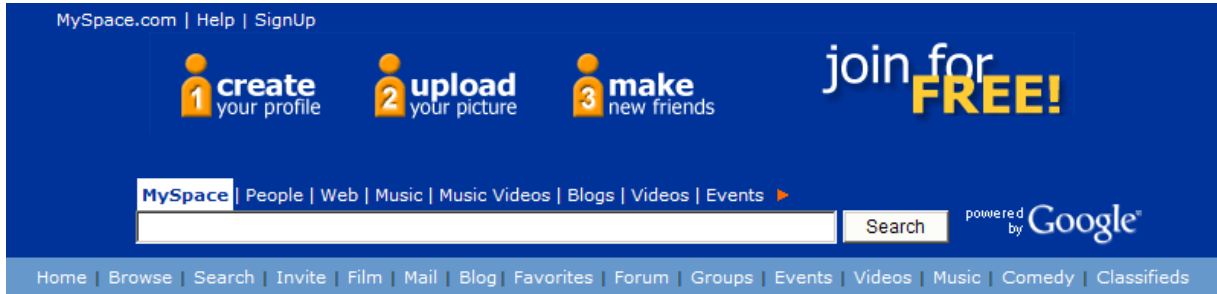

3. The next screen will show a few WAVY LETTERS. You will have to identify the letters and type them in the box to become verified.

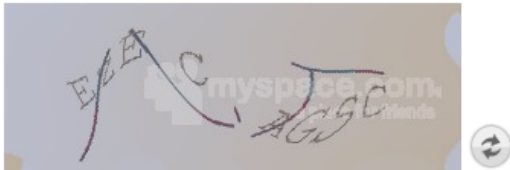


Verify Account

Requiring users to correctly enter the text from the image below is one of the ways MySpace can protect it's users from spam.

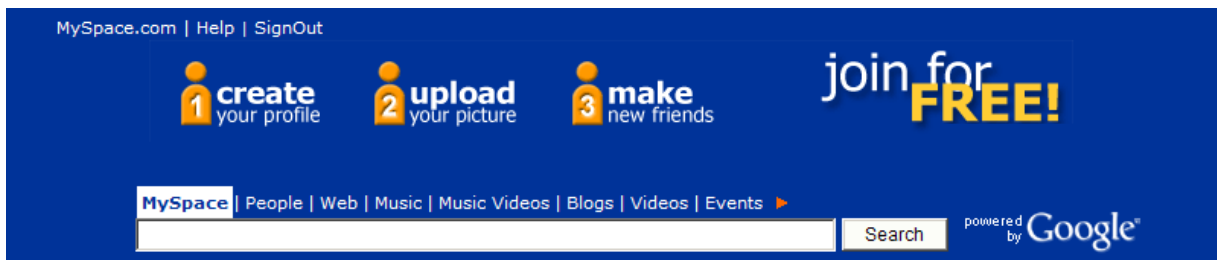

4. You can now upload photos of yourself if you wanted at this time. If you have a picture of yourself saved on your computer:

1. All you do is use **BROWSE** to find that picture. It is probably saved in a folder called **MY PICTURES**.
2. Find it and then press, **UPLOAD**. This picture will appear under your **DISPLAY NAME AND HEADLINE**.

The second step in creating your profile is sharing your photos to let friends and other members see who you are.

Photos may not contain nudity, violent or offensive material, or copyrighted images. If you violate these terms, your account will be deleted. [[photo policy](#)]

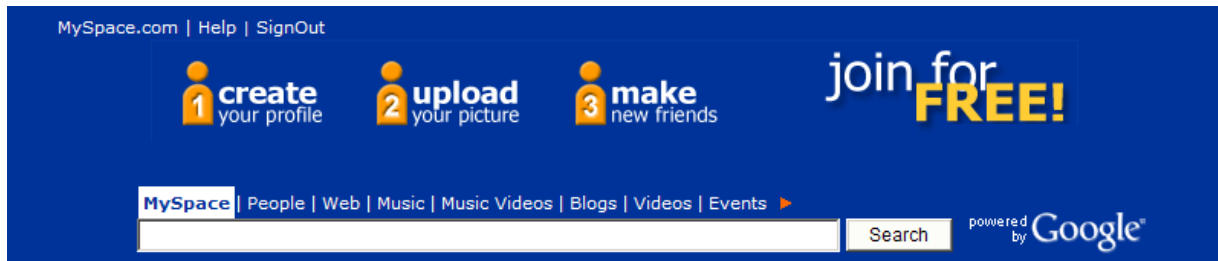

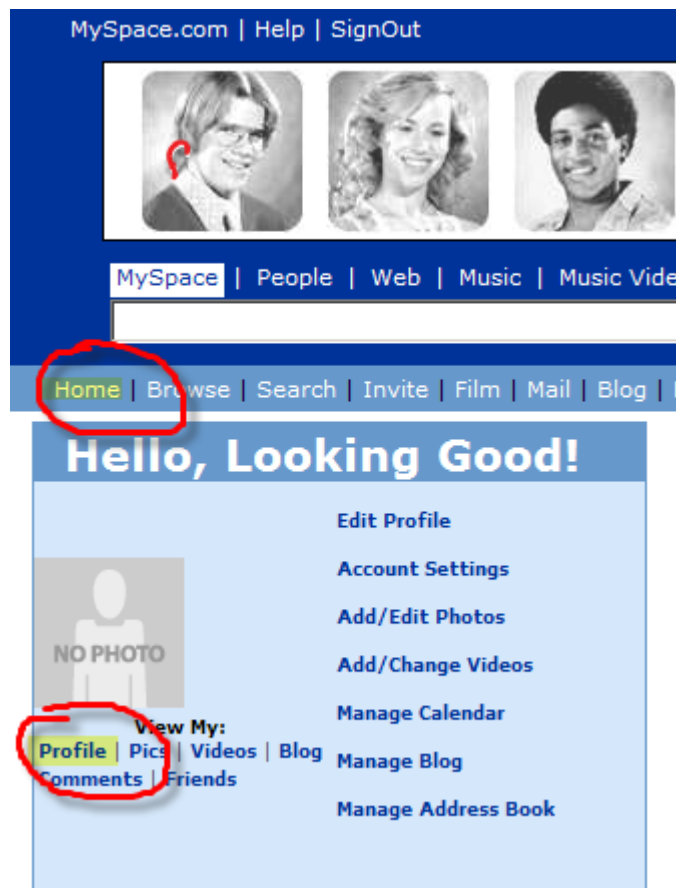

1. Whenever you're logged into MySpace and you want to return to your profile... just press **HOME** on the left side of the long horizontal right above your picture. Also, below your picture, (or where one is supposed to be), press: **VIEW MY: PROFILE** link. You will see your new friend, Tom Anderson.
